If this is your first time attending a CSSA workshop there will be equipment available for you to borrow or purchase.

Pens: My own preference is for Brause nibs but of course you can bring any dip nibs which you prefer.

Joy's group – 2.5 or 3mm nib and pen holder; Anne's group – a selection of dip nibs in sizes from 0.5mm up to 3.0mm, pen holder; **There will be all sizes of both left and right handed Brause nibs available to purchase at the meeting and also pen and nib sets for beginners to purchase.**

Paper:

Both groups -	A 4 and/or A 3 of practice paper – good copy paper or
	cartridge paper or any paper which won't bleed with your ink;
	AND your workbook if used;
	A couple of A4 sheets of tracing paper;

Ink:

Both groups - Sumi ink OR your favourite BLACK ink or gouache;

Other stuff:

Both groups -Slope board (if you have one);
ruler;
protractor;
eraser;
small water container (like a small yoghurt pot);
sharpened Hb pencil or mechanical pencil;
some kitchen roll for pen wiping;
old toothbrush to clean your nibs;
plastic sheet to cover your work table;
apron to cover your clothes;
\$5 for your attendance fee.

This list is quite basic and most people will already have everything, but if you forget something, or don't have it, then you can borrow what you need from other members.
